Before sending materials to your home, a member of the library staff may call you to discuss areas of interest which will help us better understand what types of authors and books you prefer or any other information that may be helpful. We rely on your input in the area provided on the application to tell us what you like. We encourage requests for special titles or authors at any time by either phone or email.

How Long May I Borrow The Items I Take Out?

The lending period for all items through the homebound program is 6 weeks.

What Is The Cost For The Service?

The service is free to qualified St. Clair County residents. Materials are sent in mailbags, just flip the pre-stamped mail card so our address shows and mail it back.

This program provides services to those who are unable to get to the library because of:

- ◆ Long term illness
- ◆ Recovery from surgery or illness of 6 weeks or longer
- ◆ Non-driver status (senior)
 - ◆ Physical challenge
- ◆ Problems getting out in the winter (senior)

Benefits of Homebound Services

- ◆ Personal reader advisory service to help find new authors

Why Homebound Service?

It is the library's mission to offer access to quality educational and literary reading materials to residents of all ages to meet their personal and educational needs. This program lets us fulfill our mission and serve the community better by offering our services to residents who, for various reasons, are unable to visit the library.

Do I Need To Be A St. Clair County Resident To Receive Homebound Services?

Yes. If you live in St Clair County you are eligible for this service.
